News from David John, Registrar General:

Since the release of the family history service in 2013 the cost of historical images and certificates has not changed.

As of 4 July 2016 the cost for these products will increase. The prices will be as follows:

- Historical images \$20.70
- Historical certificates \$29
- Commemorative ANZAC Death certificates \$29

It will still be free to search our historical records.
